consistency and quality of food, and service to the city of Minneapolis was of the greatest importance. To this day, many of Marie Murray's recipes and seasonings are used without alteration. And, like his father, Pat

In addition to his work at Murray's, Pat expanded his second company, *Service Ideas*, to supply thousands of hotels and restaurants around the world with innovative service industry products.
